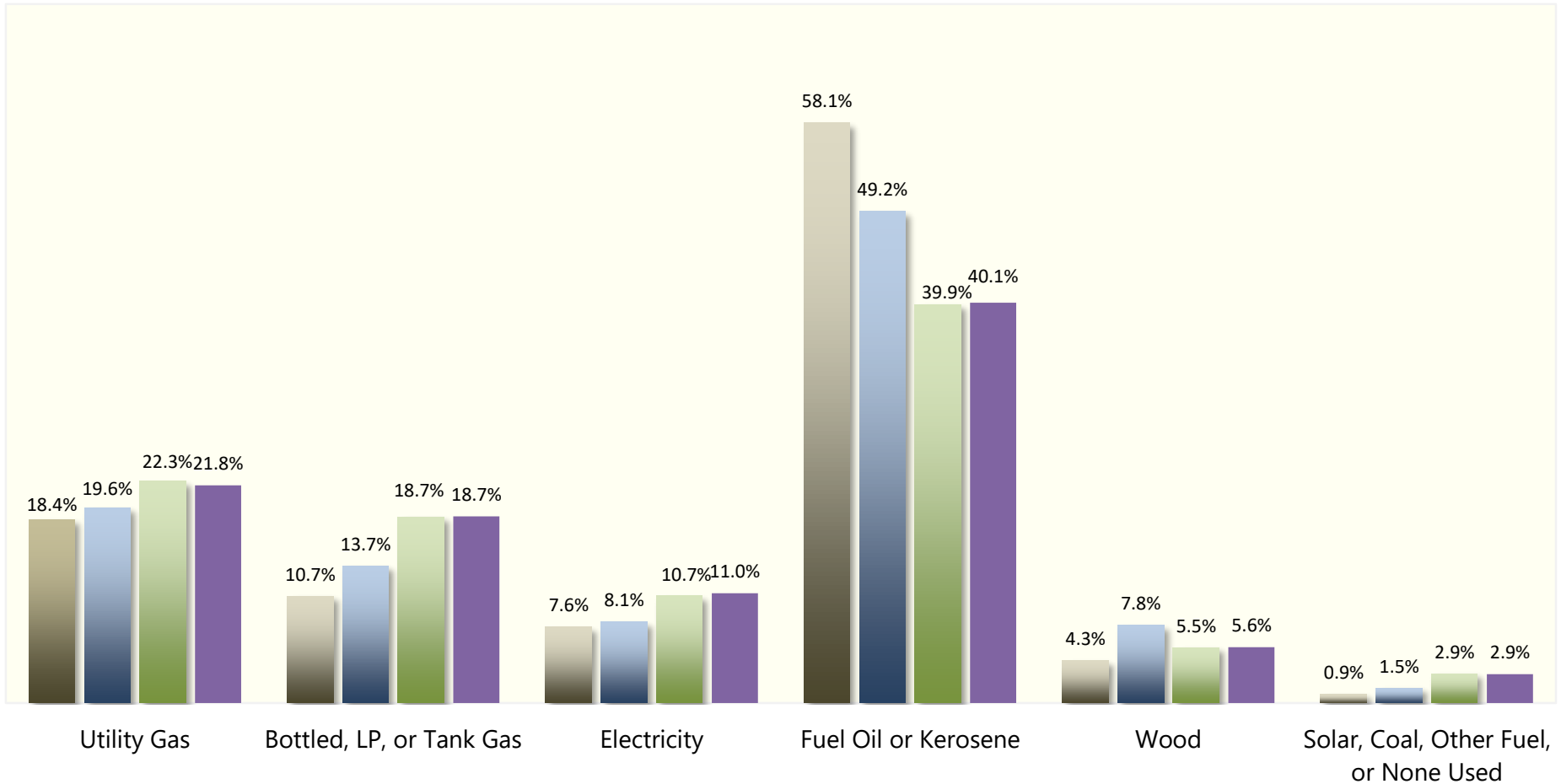


House Heating Fuel, Occupied Housing Units
