The U.S. Department of Labor has determined all workers of Aclara Meters LLC, a subsidiary of Aclara Technologies, a subsidiary of Hubbell Inc., including on-site leased workers from NESC Staffing, Somersworth, New Hampshire, have been adversely impacted by trade.

As a result, affected workers totally or partially separated from employment on or after February 28, 2019 through two years from the date of certification, and all workers in the group threatened with total or partial separation from employment as of June 9, 2020 the date of certification through two years from the date of certification, are eligible to apply for adjustment assistance under Chapter 2 of Title II of the Trade Act of 1974.

Affected workers may be eligible to receive weekly cash benefits; financial assistance for remedial or vocational training programs/ travel allowances to and from training; job search expenses; relocation allowances; Reemployment Trade Adjustment Assistance (RTAA); and other reemployment services such as resume preparation, employment counseling and job referrals.
