Provide individual, marital, and family counseling to adults and children. Help clients identify personal and interactive problems to achieve personal, marital, and family development and adjustment.

## Legislation

Statute: NH RSA 330-A:21

Administrative Rules: Chapter Mhp 100 - 500

## Licensure Requirements

- Master's degree or Doctorate in marriage and family therapy from an accredited program
- Pass national exam of the Association for Marriage and Family Therapy Regulatory Boards
- Complete a minimum of two years Post-Master's experience in a mental health counseling setting, including a minimum of 1,000 hours of practice of marriage and family therapy under an approved AAMFT supervisor and 200 hours of face-to-face supervision by an approved AAMFT supervisor

## Examination

Written examination required —  
National Examination in Marital and Family Therapy of the Association of Marital and Family Regulatory Boards

## Continuing Education

Forty continuing education hours (CEUs) every two years, and 20 hours of collaboration per year
