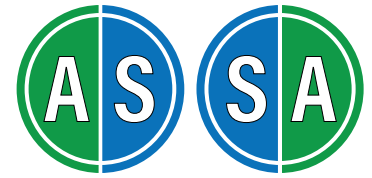


Teachers
