
Solid Waste Advanced Operator Level III

Solid Waste Advanced Operators deal with a wide range of solid waste problems. A Level III Advanced Operator may be in responsible charge of transfer stations, recycling centers, and compost facilities that accept up to thirty tons per day of waste or monofills that receive only scrap metal, demolition debris, or asbestos.

Certification Requirements

- Must have a high school diploma or equivalent. One year of experience may be substituted for one year of grade or high school, up to a maximum of one year.
- A minimum of three years experience in a related field. For Level III Advanced Operators, one year of college education may be substituted for one year of experience, up to a maximum of two years. High school education may not be substituted for experience.
- Education applied toward experience shall not be applied toward the education requirement
- First-time applicants must complete the Department's Basic Solid Waste Operator Training Course
