Solid Waste Attendants deal with a smaller range of solid waste problems. Level I Attendants are eligible to be employed at any solid waste facility, but may not be in responsible charge.

- Must have completed eighth grade
- Must have one year of experience in a related field
- For Level I attendants only, there is an attendant-in-training classification. A certified applicant shall be an attendant-in-training until the experience requirement is fulfilled
- First-time applicants must complete the Department's Basic Solid Waste Operator Training Course
