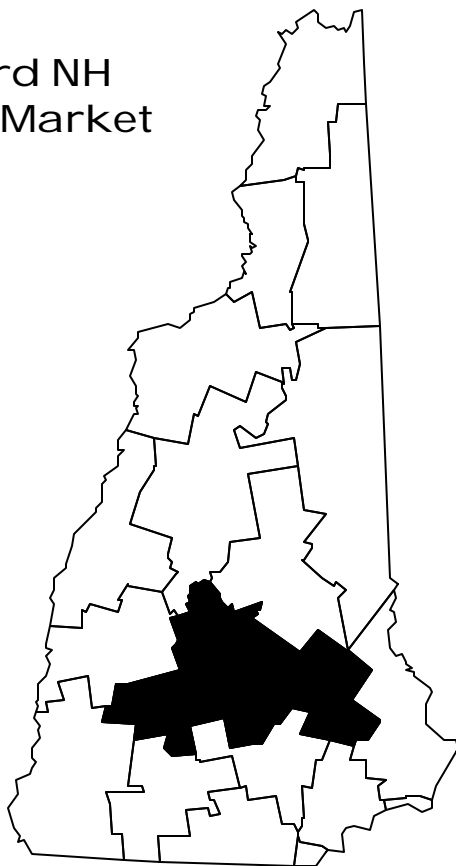


5.0 Concord NH Labor Market Area



The two cities and twenty-eight towns that make up the Concord NH LMA had a total of 62,242 residents reported working in 1990. Of that number, 22,462 stayed in their place of residence to work, while 39,780 commuted out to another city, town, or state. Workers commuting in from within the LMA, the state, or from out-of-state amounted to 32,431, and combined with the in-town resident workers totaled 54,893. In checking Table 5.1, the City of Concord, led all municipalities with 17,775 residents reported working, and having 31,096 total workers in the city. Concord also easily

had the largest “work in city” rate with 68.4%, as most other communities sent the majority of their workers out of town for employment. Comparing the “work in city/town” rate of the 30 communities, 24 locations yielded percentage rates lower than 30 percent. Conversely, these low rates effected a high percentage of nonresidents commuting in, the highest being 83.8% for the Town of Bow, followed by 81.3% for Tilton. With a large number of workers moving about, commuting-out rates ran high. Looking at all the cities/towns, two-thirds (20) had commuting-out rates of 75 percent or more, the largest rate (89.2%) produced by Salisbury commuters. No less than three interstates, three US routes, and ten urban and rural routes make up the complex network of roadways that connect the 30 cities/towns of the Concord LMA.

More Concord LMA workers commuted to the City of Concord than to any other city/town within or outside the LMA. Concord was first on the lists for 21 LMA towns on Table 5.2. The total commuters from the towns to the city numbered 11,466. That LMA commuter number amounted to over 60 percent of Concord’s commuting-in total. Many of the roadways mentioned above pass through, intersect, or touch portions of Concord. Routes such as I93, I393, US3, US4, NH13, and NH132 are examples of commuting avenues in and out of Concord. Manchester, although outside the LMA, posted the number two ranking for those commuting out by placing first, second, or third on 20 lists of the 30 LMA cities/towns. Placing the City of Concord aside, and looking at simply numbers, Pembroke (3,149) and Bow (2,584) provided the largest tally of residents commuting to another town or out of state to

work. On the subject of out-of-state commuting, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, followed by Maine and then Vermont, received the largest number of Concord LMA workers. Bay State cities such as Boston and Cambridge, and the Town of Andover were the destinations for many of the commuters. Kittery was the recipient of the largest number of workers bound for Maine, most of these from eastern towns nearer the seacoast and with easy access to Route US4 or the Spaulding Turnpike.

As previously stated, the City of Concord enjoyed the largest number of commuters for most categories, including nonresidents commuting in with 18,937. Bow, Pembroke, and Manchester were the leaders in providing workers commuting to Concord with 1,440, 1,347, and 1,213, respectively. Following the Capital City, other towns in the LMA with sizable commuting-in numbers were Bow and Tilton (see Table 5.3). Concord and Manchester were the chief providers for Bow, while Northfield and the City of Franklin furnished the largest number of workers to Tilton, possibly travelling Routes US3 and NH11. On an out-of-state note, Massachusetts sent the greatest number of workers to the Concord LMA during the census period, with Maine not far behind. The Massachusetts cities of Lawrence and Lowell and the Town of Georgetown, were among the leading providers from a field of Bay State communities. York and Wells supplied a corresponding assembly of commuters from Maine. During the census period the City of Franklin and the Town of Warner each had workers travelling in from Vermont towns like Hartford and Westminster.
