

The number of towns in the New Hampshire portion of the Lawrence MA PMSA remained unchanged, but change did occur as three towns were released to other redefined Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas (SMSAs), and three towns were added from the former unattached estimating area. Table 11.1 lists the population and summary of commuting numbers for the thirteen towns that make up the current New Hampshire portion of the bistate PMSA. The Massachusetts portion includes two cities and eight towns, such as Haverhill, Lawrence, Andover, and Methuen. This parrative and Tables 11.1 to 11.3 will be

concerned strictly with the thirteen town New Hampshire portion of the Lawrence PMSA. Travelling the roadways of the PMSA takes in many routes. Some of the roadways are NH28, NH102, NH125, and even I93 serves as a possible commute path from Derry to Windham. Other connecting urban and rural routes include NH107, NH108, NH111, and NH121. The New Hampshire portion totals for the number of estimated residents working and the combined resident/nonresident workforce were 61,087 and 33,486, respectively. The number of workers employed in their town of residence numbered 12.702. The number of residents that commuted out of town, including those who went out of state, was 48,385. Finally, the number of nonresidents that traveled into any of the towns in the New Hampshire portion of the PMSA, whether from New Hampshire cities/towns or out of state, totaled 20.784

Commuting-out numbers were sizable for all 13 towns, ranging from a high of more than 13,000 (Derry), to lows of just slightly over 1,200 (Danville and Fremont) and 1,169 (Chester). Large commuting-out numbers ordinarily generate high commuting out rates. Two towns had rates in excess of 90 percent; eight towns had rates in the 80-89 percent range. Table 11.2 points out the lowest rate was Salem's 68.6% generated by 9,676 commuters, with over 8,100 going out-of-state. Most crossed the town's southern or eastern boundary into Massachusetts. The largest commute numbers were generated by Derry, with 1,357 workers travelling to Salem, 1,263 going to Manchester, 888 to Londonderry, and 629 to Nashua. The only other town to generate significant in-state figures was Raymond, which sent 520 workers to Manchester along NH27 and/or NH101. As a portion of the

commute-out totals, out-of-state numbers were also high. Salem provided 1,174 workers to Andover MA and 1,170 to Lawrence MA.

Derry's largest out-of-state commute number was 889 to Andover. As the individual Massachusetts town data suggests, the Bay State received a larger number of New Hampshire portion Lawrence PMSA commuters than any other state. The total number of New Hampshire portion commuters to travel across the MA/NH border was 27,998. Of course, many of the municipalities like Haverhill, Andover, and Methuen are part of the Massachusetts portion of the PMSA, as explained above.

Table 11.3 displays the PMSA commute-in numbers and rates, figures that are decisively smaller than those on Table 11.2. The nonresident numbers range from a low of 107 (Sandown) to 9,308 (Salem). The majority of commute-in rates fell in the 50-59 percent range as evidenced by seven of the thirteen PMSA towns. Large individual town numbers were produced by Derry commuters travelling to Salem. Those numbers were followed by 737 Londonderry residents commuting along NH102 to Derry, and 404 Atkinson workers going to Plaistow following NH121. Bay Staters, 4,682 strong, traveled to work in the New Hampshire portion of the PMSA. Many of the towns furnishing the workers were from the Massachusetts portion of the PMSA (see above). The town of Salem provided a good example of this by taking in 692 Massachusetts workers from Methuen, 377 from Lawrence, and 296 from Haverhill. Windsor VT furnished all seven of the Vermonters working in the town of Newton during the census period.
