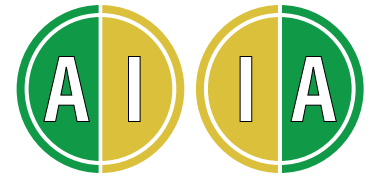


# Imaginers
