What Is Project Running Start?

Running Start is a partnership between the Community Colleges of NH and high schools to give students an opportunity to take college courses while also completing the requirements for high school graduation. Last year, over 4,000 high school students enrolled in CCSNH college courses offered at more than 70 participating NH high schools. CCSNH courses are not extra classes taken before or after school. They are part of the daily class schedule at your high school.

How Can Project Running Start Help Me?
