Coös County covers the top fifth of the state, sharing a 71-mile straight border with Maine to the east, an 85-mile border with Vermont to the west, and a 58-mile border with Canada to the north. Established in 1803, the county was named after the Indian word 'cowass' or 'kohass,' meaning 'crooked river' because of the bend in the Connecticut River. The White Mountain National Forest and Nash Stream State Forest cover a sizable portion of the county.



Coös County contains 1,801.5 square miles of land area and 29.7 square miles of inland water area. As of the 2020 Census, the population density was 17.4 persons per square mile. Coös County includes one city, Berlin, 19 towns, and 23 unincorporated places, 14 of which were unpopulated as of the 2020 Census. The county seat is Lancaster.
