Grafton County occupies the west central border of the state, halfway between north and south. It is separated from Vermont by an 89-mile stretch of the Connecticut River. Like Coös County, Grafton covers nearly one-fifth of the state. It was one of the five original counties established in 1769, and was comprised of all of the current Grafton and Coös Counties until 1803. The county, like the town, takes its name from Augustus Henry Fitzroy, Duke of Grafton, an enthusiastic supporter of the American cause prior to the Revolution. The county contains a substantial amount of inland water, most of which is Newfound Lake or part of Squam Lake, as well as half of the White Mountain National Forest.

Grafton County contains 1,708.6 square miles of land area and 41.1 square miles of inland water area. As of the 2023 Census, the population density was 54.5 persons per square mile. Grafton County includes one city, Lebanon, 38 towns, and one unincorporated place, Livermore. The county seat is Haverhill.
