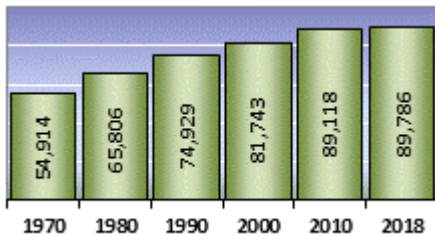


Grafton County

Grafton County occupies the west central border of the state, halfway between north and south. It is separated from Vermont by an 89-mile stretch of the Connecticut River. Like Coös County, Grafton covers nearly one-fifth of the state. It was one of the five original counties established in 1769, and was comprised of all of the current Grafton and Coös Counties until 1803. The county, like the town, takes its name from Augustus Henry Fitzroy, Duke of Grafton, an enthusiastic supporter of the American cause prior to the Revolution. The county contains a substantial amount of inland water, most of which is Newfound Lake or part of Squam Lake, and includes half of the White Mountain National Forest.



Grafton County contains 1,709.0 square miles of land area and 40.8 square miles of inland water area. Based on the 2010 Census population, the population density is 52.2 persons per square mile. Grafton County includes one city, Lebanon, 38 towns, and one unincorporated place, Livermore. The county seat is Haverhill.



Population Trends: Over the last five decennial periods, Grafton County has experienced population growth below the state average rate, with no substantial growth spurts. The county's fastest rate of growth was from 1970 to 1980, when the population increased by 19.8 percent. Grafton is the second largest county in land area, following Coös County. Population density for Grafton County is about equal to that of Carroll County, which is 0.8 square miles smaller.
