Incorporated: 1876

Origin: This township was a portion of Landaff known as Eastern Landaff from the time of that town's incorporation in 1774 until it was made a separate community and incorporated as Easton in 1867. The name seems to be a corruption of the word Eastern. One of the earliest settlers in Eastern Landaff was Asa Kinsman, and it is for this family that Mount Kinsman, the Kinsman Range, and Kinsman Notch are named. Like many New England families, the Kinsman family purchased land in Ohio, and there is still a town named Kinsman in Trumbull County, Ohio.

Population Trends: Population change for Easton totaled 200 over 50 years, from 92 in 1970 to 292 in 2020. The largest decennial percent change was a 79 percent increase from 1980 to 1990. The town's population increased by 15 percent from 2010 to 2020. The 2022 Census estimate for Easton was 300 residents, which ranked 227th among New Hampshire's incorporated cities and towns, the eighth smallest community.
