Incorporated: 1761

Origin: Grantham was named for Thomas Robinson, first Baron Grantham, an active supporter of American independence. He was known as a diplomat in Europe and was one of Great Britain's first postmaster-generals. The area was first granted in 1761, the same year Robinson received his peerage. No settlers took up that claim, and the land was regranted in 1767 as New Grantham. In 1780, the western portion of Grantham and the eastern portion of Plainfield were made into the parish of Meriden, a name the region bears today. The town was incorporated as New Grantham in 1788, and incorporated as Grantham in 1818.

Population Trends: Population change for Grantham totaled 2,579 over 49 years, from 366 in 1970 to 2,945 in 2019. The largest decennial percent change was 92 percent between 1970 and 1980,

followed by increases of 77 and 75 percent, respectively over the next two decades. The

2019 Census estimate for Grantham was 2,945 residents, which ranked 110th among New Hampshire's incorporated cities and towns.
