
Harrisville, NH



Incorporated: 1870

Origin: First settled in 1760, the town was formed from parts of Hancock, Dublin, Roxbury, Nelson, and Marlborough. The town was first known as Twitchellville, after Abel Twitchell. His daughter Deborah married Bethuel Harris, who, with his sons, built and operated Harris Mills, one of the first woolen mills in New England. After the business was sold, the name was changed to Cheshire Mills. The town was incorporated in 1871 as Harrisville, at the suggestion of Milan Harris, one of Bethuel's sons and a member of the state senate from 1863-1865. The Harrisville Historic District is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Population, Year of the First Census Taken: 870 residents in 1880

Population Trends: Population change for Harrisville totaled 402 over 50

years, from 584 in 1970 to 986 in 2020. The largest decennial percent change was a 47 percent increase from 1970 to 1980. The town's population increased by three percent from 2010 to 2020. The 2022 Census estimate for Harrisville was 1,000 residents, which ranked 188th among New Hampshire's incorporated cities and towns.

Population Density and Land Area, 2022 (US Census Bureau): 53.4 persons per square mile of land area. Harrisville contains 18.7 square miles of land area and 1.5 square miles of inland water area.
