Licensure Requirements

- Minimum requirement of 1,500 hours in not less than one year of apprenticeship training under a qualified licensee

Examination

Not required

Continuing Education

Three hours of continuing education for each individual classification, and completion of a sterilization course

Reciprocity

Permitted — Applicant must have documentation of practicing in another state for at least three years
