These professionals are ensuring the health and safety of medical imaging and radiation therapy patients by using standardized techniques in patient positioning, examination and treatment techniques, equipment protocols, radiation safety, radiation protection, and basic patient care. Examples of these healthcare technicians are limited x-ray machine operators, medical imaging professionals, and radiation therapists.

- Reached the age of 18 years old
- Obtained a high school diploma or its equivalent
- Good professional character and reliability
- Specific course of study, certification and examination vary for each of the following professionals: Limited X-Ray Machine Operator, Magnetic Resonance Technologist, Nuclear Medicine Technologist, Radiation Therapist, Radiographer, Radiologist Assistants, Sonographer.
