Medical Technician

A medical technician is any health care worker who assists licensed health care professionals in the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of disease but who is not licensed or registered by a specific New Hampshire regulatory board. Under this regulation, Medical technicians are limited to health care workers with access to controlled substances and with access to or contact with patients in a health care facility or in a medical establishment. Medical technicians do not include a nurse licensed in another state who is working in New Hampshire under the Nurse Licensure Compact.

Registration Requirements

- An applicant must submit:
 - A completed application and pay the appropriate fee
 - A two-inch by two-inch passport quality photograph taken within 90 days of the date of application
 - Criminal history records check form and fingerprint card, seeking both a New Hampshire and a federal records check in accordance with the procedure specified by the New Hampshire Department of Safety at Saf-C 5700, Operation of the Central Repository
- Individuals are provided with a temporary registration until the criminal background check is received by this office. Once the background check is received and the individual is deemed appropriate to be registered a full registration is granted. The temporary registration is good for 180 days.
