# **Licensure Requirements**

- Sixty credit Master's degree or Doctoral degree in clinical mental health counseling, including a 700-hour practicum or internship appropriate to mental health counseling
- Must pass the National Clinical Mental Health Counselor exam
- Complete a minimum of two years of paid, post-Master's experience in a mental health setting including a minimum of 3,000 hours of postmaster's supervised clinical experience and a minimum of 100 hours of faceto-face supervision
- Must complete a criminal background check

## **Examination**

Written examination required — National Clinical Mental Health Counseling exam

## **Continuing Education**

40 hours of continuing education units (CEUs) every two years, and 40 hours of collaboration every two years
