Hello, I'm Josh from New Hampshire Employment Security.

The Job Match System, also known as JMS, is one of the resources available to both job seekers and employers. You can access it online, or free internet access is available in any one of the NH Works Centers.

Job seekers can find assistance with looking for or getting placed in a new job, learn how to develop effective résumés and cover letters and can save multiple résumés for targeted job searches. There is a database of current job openings, which you can search by title, employer, education, skills, personal résumé criteria, or the job number. You can set up a virtual recruiter to send you messages when jobs are posted that meet your qualifications. You can search specific occupations, or new career options by analyzing your current job or personal skills, interests, and work values to find an occupation that best suits you.

If you need to upgrade your skills, JMS has information on training and educational programs and schools, including online resources. You can even research the number of people who have completed training and educational programs for a specific occupation. Another benefit of JMS is that you can view the searches you have made for jobs, employers, training programs, occupations, and industries.

For employers, JMS is a valuable resource for posting job openings, finding qualified candidates, reviewing online candidate's résumés. Employers can also assess current job market trends based on the job orders in the system, and candidate trends based on the applicants who have applied for your positions.

Labor market services are available to provide a wide variety of economic information for various regions, including facts about the local labor market, or a specific area, industry or occupational profile.
