

Notice of Trade Certification

Acme Staple Company, Inc.

All Workers

Franklin, NH

The U.S. Department of Labor has determined that all workers of Acme Staple Company, Inc., Franklin, NH have been adversely impacted by Trade.

As a result, affected workers totally or partially separated from employment on or after July 17, 2019 and before August 17, 2021 through two years from the date of certification, and all workers in the group threatened with total or partial separation from employment as of August 10, 2021 the date of certification through two years from the date of certification, are eligible to apply for adjustment assistance under Chapter 2 of Title II of the Trade Act of 1974.

Affected workers may be eligible to receive weekly cash benefits; financial assistance for remedial or vocational training programs/ travel allowances to and from training; job search expenses; relocation allowances; Reemployment Trade Adjustment Assistance (RTAA); and other reemployment services such as resume preparation, employment counseling and job referrals.
